


# CO-LINE




Situation plan

Co-line is placed on the edge of Pernis with a view of the Harbor and surrounded by trees and greenery that grows up the façade. It is a small community consisting of 20 apartments for various household sizes and a Common House with the opportunity to move your workspace away from your home.

The two building volumes frame a common courtyard with visual contact from all apartments across the yard. Two large openings on each end of the courtyard invites the public through the green garden with fruit trees, plants, and wild grass that grows all around. Here it is possible to do diverse activities or relax and enjoy the life that the community is creating around you. Through crossing movement patterns that create informal meetings between residents, new connections are created.

The household will spend most of their time inside their apartments. Therefore, the environment will create a healthy home through visual, atmospheric, and thermal comfort with focus on indoor operative temperatures as well as air pollution. Here, it is possible to pull back from the community and enjoy the view over the water or the green common yard, just outside your window. You can also stay on the balconies or terraces that creates a connection between the apartments and the common space.




